## No Show/Payment Policy

In order to maximize the amount of well-coordinated, effective, and efficient treatment services, Southwestern Mental Health Center's physicians and staff will adhere to the following no show policy:

- 1. To ensure your appointment is not considered a "no show", please call our office prior to your scheduled appointment to cancel.
- 2. Individuals who fail to cancel or show for their appointments or who have a pattern of missing appointments may be placed on Southwestern Mental Health Center's client waitlist for services.
- 3. Individuals placed on the Southwestern Mental Health Center waitlist will need to call the office to initiate and coordinate availability of services.
- 4. Individuals are expected to provide copays and/or payment for services at the time of the service. Clients with a balance of over \$100 may not be scheduled for future sessions until payment is received or arrangements are made for a payment plan.
- 5. Individuals who have unpaid balances in collections will not be scheduled for ongoing services until payment is made and/or arrangements are made with the Southwestern Mental Health Center Billing Department.
